Comments: We request these changes be made to the Student Government Association Code of Laws, Article Five, Section 5, "Sub-section 1.

Let Article Five, Section 5, of the SGA Constitution now read:

Section 5: Absences

(1) An executive officer of the Student Government Association shall be considered in absence if he/she is absent, unexcused, from any meeting of the Executive Cabinet; or absent, unexcused, from one meeting of the Student Senate during a semester. One additional excused absence, deemed by the SGA advisor, is permitted during the semester. If the officer is found to be in absence, he/she shall be required to forfeit the office. Additionally, if the officer has not executed his/her powers and duties for a period of five class days, the officer will be considered in absence.
