Title: Limited Smoking near University of Montevallo Academic Buildings

WHEREAS: Many students feel that they should not have to walk through hazardous cigarette smoke when going to classes, AND

WHEREAS: A large number of students and faculty members are exposed to smoking on a daily basis when walking to and from classes, AND

WHEREAS: Some students have ailments such as asthma or allergies to cigarette smoke, AND

WHEREAS: Many smokers congregate directly outside entrances to academic buildings,

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED BY THE UNIVERSITY OF MONTEVALLO STUDENT SENATE: That smokers will only be allowed to smoke if they are twenty-five feet away or more from all academic building entrances. Specifically, smokers near Harman Hall will be designated the entrance nearest Hill House. Those students attending classes in Comer Hall will only be allowed to smoke on the side of Comer hall that has the two small benches.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT: These new rules shall be designated with the appropriate signage. Any smoker(s) found in violation of this resolution shall be asked to move to the designated smoking area and if said student refuses, campus police shall be called to enforce this resolution.
