### Recognition

**Honors Certificate:** Successful completion of 18 hours of Honors courses qualifies you for the Honors Certificate. You will receive a physical certificate at Honors Day in the Fall.

Honors Diploma: Successful completion with an "A" or "B" of 26 hours of any combination of HNRS courses, including the Golson Seminar (HNRS 400), while maintaining a 3.2 or above GPA, qualifies you for the Honors Diploma, which will also be noted on your transcript as well as at graduation. You will also be recognized with a physical certificate at Honors Day in the Spring and Honors Cords to wear at graduation.
