

Communication Science and Disorders Ambassadors

Purpose: The CSD Ambassadors will represent the program to potential students and families attending recruiting events, share knowledge of the program, and answer questions from attendees. They will assist at campus events like health fairs or hearing screenings. They will facilitate interaction between the undergraduate and graduate students in the department.

Minimum Qualifications:

- Admitted to the CSD Junior Class or enrolled as a first-year graduate student in SLP
- Knowledge of the undergraduate curriculum, university admission practices, campus life, and the fields of Speech-Language Pathology and Audiology
- A passion for the University of Montevallo
- A demonstrated passion for the major and professions
- GPA of 3.0 or higher
- Strong interpersonal skills, professional poise, and a friendly personality
- Active participation in NSSLHA preferred

Requirements/Duties: Those chosen as CSD Ambassadors will assist with university preview days and recruiting events for the department. Attendance at one preview day per year is required. Attendance at a portion of the Day in the Life recruiting event is required. Reasonable participation in other tours, meetings, and campus/community events as requested. Organize a fall social between the first and second year graduates and a spring social between undergraduates and graduate students. Secure two graduate students to speak to the CSD Juniors (in CSD 393 or 394) about GRE preparation.

The group will need two officers, a President and an Events Chair.

President: Maintain a roster of the organization and a record of each student's participation in events. Communicate with the Department Chair to secure volunteers for the upcoming functions. Plan and order name tags and/or shirts for the group. Coordinate the election of the next officers.

Events Chair: Plan the fall and spring social events. Coordinate the GRE preparation discussion.
