Transfer students seeking to select courses that most closely match degree programs in Mathematics at the University of Montevallo should choose the following Alabama community college course options from the [AGSC Guide](#). A maximum of sixty-four hours of credit will transfer from a two-year college.

Area V - Pre-Professional, Major, & Elective Courses. Select up to 23 semester hours.

MTH 125 – Calculus I
MTH 126 - Calculus II
MTH 227 - Calculus III

Select 8 hours of science with lab at the 200 level or above in Biology, Chemistry, or Physics.

(If not taken in [Area II](#)) choose:

SPH 106 – Fundamentals of Oral Communication *or* SPH 107 – Fundamentals of Public Speaking

One additional 3 semester hour course in [Area II](#)

For a B.A. degree – fill the remaining hours working toward completion of the sophomore-level of a foreign language.

For a B.S. degree – requirements are satisfied through the major requirements.

Additional hours in Area V may be fulfilled with general electives.
