**A student desiring to sit for the CPA exam in Alabama must take 1) all accounting courses for the accounting major (total of 30 hours--seven required courses and three elective courses) and 2) one additional AC Accounting upper-level course as the Business Electives Required, for a total of 33 Accounting hours. Additionally, to obtain an Alabama CPA license, applicants must have completed a total of 150 hours of postsecondary education per the Alabama statute.
