## Question Comments

### What aspects of your internship did you feel most prepared for? Explain.

- Lesson Planning, actually teaching the lessons, and taking on the role as the teacher.
- I felt very prepared going into internship because of the preparation Montevallo gives you. You learn and grow so much from semester to semester which makes internship much easier.
- I felt the most prepared for lesson planning and classroom management. These are two things I felt I learned a lot about in my Education program and also during my field placements. Applying what I learned and practiced to internship came much easier than if I had little to no exposure to good practices for managements and planning.
- The actual teaching; the professors prepared us for what to expect regarding content areas and classroom management
- All of the preparation for edTPA left me feeling very confident once I completed it during internship.
- Lesson plans - We had multiple opportunities to practice creating lesson plans throughout the entire program.
- I felt the most prepared on how to create lesson plans, use Livetext, expectations of all blocks and internship, and content knowledge.
- I felt that I was prepared for edTPA.
- ELA, I feel that I had more background knowledge of the content

### What aspects of your internship did you feel least prepared for? Explain.

- edTPA time requirements
- I felt least prepared for the beginning and how fast EdTPA was.
- I felt least prepared for accommodating students with special needs in the classroom. This includes the students in my class who are in Special Education, ELLs, Tier 2 and Tier 3, and also IEPS. I felt that I learned about in class but did not get a lot of practice applying it during my time in the education program prior to internship. However, I now feel much more confident in teaching these students and accommodating their needs.
- edTPA; the process was overwhelming while teaching at the same time, the rubrics were kind of hard to understand
- I don't have any complaints for this.
- EdTPA - I do feel that I was exceptionally prepared, but I think that future interns would benefit from seminars prior to internship to thoroughly explain the process and language of EdTPA.
- I felt the least prepared for individualizing classroom management. This is mostly because of every class is different and not all strategies work best in particular classrooms. The classroom management class, however gave great strategies and ideas to use. I also felt the least prepared for planning for multiple subjects. I feel that I needed more practice with maybe planning out all subjects for a weeks worth [sic] of plans earlier in my program.
