- I would have liked to take more child development classes during the program. After completing internship, I learned that I better served the students when I understood where they were developmentally, specifically in the special education setting.

Question Comments

What aspects of your internship did you feel most prepared for? Explain.

- I felt prepared to complete edTPA through prior block experience and the bootcamps provided. I was confident in teaching each subject because of the pre-internship study of each subject and because of the requirement to teach each subject during pre-internship.
- I felt the most prepared for both lesson planning and teaching in general. Having so many placements prior to internship was so beneficial and made me feel confident beginning internship. I feel as though I would not have felt so prepared nor confident if it was not for all of the prior placements.
- I felt most prepared for building rapport with my students and teach science and guided reading. [sic]

What aspects of your internship did you feel least prepared for? Explain.

- I experienced confusion of requirements for Collaborative Education during internship. I felt like our specific requirements, like teaching two sets of 10 consecutive days and the additional certification fee were not specifically stated; therefore, I was not as prepared as I would have liked to have been for internship and its requirements.
- My second placement, special education resource, was probably what I felt the least prepared for. Since most of the program deals with general education, I feel that the brief placement I did have in my special education block did not make me feel quite as confident as my general education placement. However, I got adjusted quickly and have thoroughly enjoyed the learning experience and now feeling extremely prepared.
- I felt the least prepared entering my special education placement. It had been almost a year since my last special education placement, and I felt that I needed more experience in that setting before internship.
