- Application for admission

- Official transcripts from all colleges/universities attended
- Valid Alabama Class B Professional Educator's certificate
- Official experience form (EXP) verifying three (3) years of teaching experience.

- Passing score on an interview conducted by a program admission committee that includes both P-12 instructional leaders and higher education faculty.

Fall: July 15

Spring: November 15

Summer: April 15
