The charge of the Human and Animal Subjects Research Committee is to ensure compliance of human and animal subjects research with applicable regulations and guidelines. Specifically, the committee is charged to ensure that research involving humans follows well-established ethical guidelines which are intended to ensure that both physical and psychological risks to subjects are either minimized or eliminated as well as ensuring that participants are fully informed about the nature of research related activities and any potential risks prior to giving informed consent. The committee is also charged to ensure equitable selection of subjects. In addition, the committee must ensure that research using non-human animal subjects complies with all applicable provisions of the Animal Welfare Act and other Federal statutes and regulations relating to animals.
