History, Social & Behavioral Sciences..... 12 hours

Choose one History: HIST 101 or 103 (World Civilization I)* or HIST 102 or 104 (World Civilization II)*

**Students must take at least one six-hour sequence in Literature or History. Students may take both sequences.*
