

ELEMENTARY EDUCATION ALTERNATIVE MASTER'S



The **Elementary Education Alternative Master's program** at the University of Montevallo is for those who have earned a bachelor's degree or higher and wish to be certified to teach in Alabama.

An alternative master's degree leads to advanced (Class A) teacher certification at the elementary school level (grades K-6).

Courses in this program are offered in a face-to-face format during the mornings and afternoons. This enables candidates to gain four semesters of practical, professional experience and network in local, public elementary schools. Specifically, this program is designed to meet the needs of full-time graduate students.

COURSEWORK OVERVIEW

All coursework must be completed with a minimum overall GPA of 3.25. The edTPA assessment must be satisfactorily completed.

- Bachelor's degree (minimum 2.75 GPA) or graduate degree (minimum 3.0 GPA) from a regionally accredited college/university
- Praxis II Elementary Education: Three Subject Bundle*
- Teaching Education Program Interview
- Fingerprint/background clearance

*Minimum GPA of 2.0 allowed with a corresponding higher Praxis II score.
