

TEMPORARY SPECIAL EDUCATION CERTIFICATE



The **ONLINE Temporary Special Education Certificate (TSEC)** at the University of Montevallo is for those who have earned a bachelor's degree or higher and can be certified to teach special education in grades 6-12.

Courses taken to obtain the TSEC include a survey of special education, collaboration/consultation, methods and assessment, special education law and behavior analysis/modification. All TSEC coursework must be completed at the same university.

A completed TSEC leads to a Class B teacher certification to teach secondary collaborative special education.

COURSEWORK OVERVIEW

All coursework must be completed with the Alabama State Department of Education approved grade to be considered for the TSEC application (please see the ALSDE TSEC application for specific guidance).

- Bachelor's degree (minimum 2.75 GPA) or graduate degree (minimum 3.0 GPA) from a regionally accredited college/university
