The Alabama Motorcycle Safety Program provides Motorcycle Safety Foundation training courses at sites throughout Alabama.





Basic Rider Course (BRC)

The BRC (Basic Rider Course) is designed primarily for those who have limited or no riding experience, or for those who have been away from riding for a number of years. Course includes an online precourse session, classroom instruction and riding skills exercises.

We provide:

- Motorcycle
- Handbook
- Helmet

Basic Bike Bonding Rider Course (BBBRC)

The BBBRC is an approximately five-hour riding course designed to help develop basic riding skills. Exercises focus on a variety of cornering skills and limited-space maneuvers. By the end of the course, you should be able to handle a motorcycle well enough to negotiate normal street and traffic situations.

You provide:

- Appropriate attire
- Completion card from MSF or HDRA

We provide:

- Motorcycle
- Helmet



Basic Rider Course 2 (BRC2)

For riders who already have basic skills. Similar to BRC except speeds are higher. Excellent refresher course for practicing and renewing riding skills.

You provide:

- Street-legal motorcycle
- Appropriate attire and helmet
- Completion card from MSF Street Strategies eCourse

Advanced Rider Course (ARC)

The Advanced Rider Course is designed for proficient and experienced motorcycle riders. Rider self-assessment, risk management, rider behavior, riding strategies and overall skill development are covered.

You provide:

- Street-legal motorcycle
- Appropriate attire and helmet
- Valid driver's license with Class M endorsement

Ultimate Bike Bonding Rider Course (UBBRC)

This is for experienced riders. There is no formal classroom and the riding exercises focus on limited-space maneuvers modeled after police training courses. Through progressively challenging exercises, you will develop smooth and precise control and learn more about the limits of your abilities and your bike's capability.

You provide:

- Street-legal motorcycle
- Appropriate attire and helmet
- Valid driver's license with Class M endorsement

3-Wheel Basic Rider Course

With a 3-wheel motorcycle course, you'll learn the essentials of riding in a controlled and safe environment under the supervision of a certified instructor.

Course includes basic vehicle and throttle control, stopping, turning and shifting. Advanced skills like stopping quickly and evasive maneuvering are also covered.
