

COUNSELING MASTER'S



The Counseling Master's Program at the University of Montevallo is for those who have earned a bachelor's degree or higher and wish to pursue a career in the mental health field.

UM's counseling tracks include preparations for careers in Clinical Mental Health Counseling settings, Couples and Family Counseling, and School Counseling.

All tracks are accredited by the Council for Accreditation of Counseling Related Educational Programs (CACREP), meet the academic requirements for Alabama's LPC credential and individuals who choose Couples and Family Counseling are eligible to pursue the Licensed Marriage and Family Therapist (LMFT) license.

COURSEWORK OVERVIEW

All coursework must be completed with a minimum overall GPA of 3.0 (3.25 for School Counseling). The Counseling Preparation Comprehensive Exam must be satisfactorily completed.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- Online application at montevallo.edu/apply
- Bachelor's degree (minimum 2.5 GPA OR 2.75 for the last 60 hours) from a regionally accredited college/university
- Admission interview with counseling faculty and other program candidates
- Two letters of recommendation
- Admissions essay (four to six paragraphs on professional aspirations and goals)
- Current curriculum vitae or résumé
- Fingerprint/background clearance (School Counseling ONLY)

Conditional admission is available in some circumstances to students who have not satisfactorily met all admission requirements.
