The Graduate Teaching Award aims to recognize the crucial role that graduate faculty have in preparing students for professional careers. The award will be given based on the faculty member's positive impact on the students in one of the University of Montevallo's Graduate Programs.

The recipient must be a full-time faculty member teaching in one of the University's Graduate programs. Teaching must be their primary responsibility. This does not rule out directors, department chairs, or other instructors/professors with administrative duties. However, the recipient must spend at least half of their time in direct teaching activities at the University of Montevallo. Candidates will be selected based on their commitment to teaching and the influence that they have had on students in the teaching and learning process. Nominations may be submitted by an alumnus, a student, a university faculty member, or a university staff member. One recipient will be selected annually to receive this award.
