DUAL ENROLLMENT

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- Apply online at montevallo.edu/apply
- Master's degree (minimum 3.0 GPA) from a regionally accredited college/university
- Electronic portfolio demonstrating technical proficiency and expertise

ONE of the following criteria**:

- One year full-time professional experience in education or related field (if currently employed)
- Three years full-time professional experience in education or related field

**Other qualifications and credentials will be evaluated as needed. All qualified candidates will be considered.
