

Alabama Motorcycle Safety Program (AMSP)

Welcome to the Alabama Motorcycle Safety Program's Online Registration System. Please read this page in its entirety before choosing a course.

No Refunds / No Rescheduling

When you register and pay for your class, it means you have reserved a seat in a specific class. You are expected to be at your class for those dates and times.

Your registration and course fee does not give you a seat in future classes, it does not add your name to a new roster, nor does it reschedule you another date if you should miss or be late for any part of your original course. It is your responsibility to make sure you arrive where you need to be.

Due to increasing demand for courses, we cannot issue refunds, nor can we reschedule you into another course within 14 calendar days of the class start date. You may cancel or reschedule, without penalty, up to 14 calendar days before your class starts. There are NO refunds and NO rescheduling after this grace period.

If you miss or are late for any session, you will NOT be allowed to continue in the class and you will NOT be issued a refund nor rescheduled.

Attendance / Lateness

- You must attend all sessions:
 - Complete the 5-hour (approx.) self-paced e-Course: Included in fees.
 - Students will receive an email containing the course access URL **two (2) weeks prior to the course start-date**

- Students must show the E-course completion certificate (**completed within 30 days of in-person training**) to Rider Coaches at the start of class. You will not be admitted without it.
 - 11 (approx.) hours of on-motorcycle training and Motorcycle Skill Test
- Failure to attend any portion of a course session results in being dropped from the course. No Refunds.
- There are no make-up classes.
- Classes start promptly, it is your responsibility to be on time. Being late to the start of any portion of the course, **WILL** result in being dropped from the course. No Refunds.
- Due to variables beyond our control, such as weather, some course times may need to be extended. Allow additional time in your course schedule in case a session runs later than scheduled.
- Class hours may be extended or adjusted during any session. We ask that you do not commit to any other appointments on the days or evenings of your scheduled classes.

Cancellations

Construction, site emergencies, or unforeseen conflicts at our sites may require us to reschedule or cancel a course. In these extreme cases, we will make a reasonable attempt to find alternative meeting times, dates and/or locations for affected students but cannot guarantee we will be able to accommodate everyone. If AMSP cancels or reschedules your course, you may choose to reschedule or receive a refund.

Minors (Under the age of 18)

Students under the age of 18 **MUST** have a parent or legal guardian accompany them to the first meeting to sign a waiver form. Students under the age of 18 will **NOT** be allowed to attend unless a parent or legal guardian is present at the first classroom session (**NO EXCEPTIONS**).

Weather

- Dress for weather conditions
- We rarely cancel a course because of weather.

You must bring:

- Picture identification (driver license, student ID, employment ID, state ID, military ID, etc.). Minors/parents provide birth certificate if necessary. Completed E Course certificate.

You will not be permitted to participate in the course unless you wear:

- Long-sleeve shirt or jacket
- Long pants (heavy denim or riding pants recommended; no holes and not torn)
- Over-the-ankle boots (sturdy, not canvas). No tennis shoes.
- Eye protection, Sunglasses, eyeglasses.
- Full-finger gloves (bring your own)
- DOT approved helmet, AMSP Provides a helmet.
- We suggest you bring water, snacks, sunscreen, lawn chair.

AMSP provides:

- Helmet (for Basic Course)
- Face shield (for Basic Course)
- Motorcycle (for Basic Course)

Motorcycling is Not for Everyone

Motorcycling is not for everyone. Some students may discover this for themselves during the course. At other times, struggling or uncertain students may be counseled out and unable to continue in the riding sessions. AMSP trained Coaches are required to maintain the safety of all participants. Any student creating an unsafe condition, as determined by the Coaches, will not be allowed to continue in the course.

There are NO refunds available for non-completion of the course.
