DAY CAMP

This experience includes a Sunday late afternoon and evening orientation and rehearsal, group rehearsal and instruction from 8:30 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday-Friday, and concluding recitals and concerts beginning at 11 a.m. on Friday. Day camp participant drop-off is 8 to 8:30 a.m. and pick-up is 5 to 5:30 p.m. at Davis Hall. Performance T-shirt and lunch is included in the day camp tuition of \$250.

OVERNIGHT CAMP

A comprehensive overnight experience, including comfortable housing, all-you-can-eat meals, group rehearsals and instruction, performance T-shirt, and admittance to all evening programs and activities. Accommodations include spacious suites for up to four students with a shared living area/kitchenette, four private single bedrooms, and two shared bathrooms per suite. Overnight camp tuition is \$450, and space is limited to just 100 participants.

OPTIONAL PRIVATE LESSONS

Private lessons with our world-renowned faculty are available at a rate of \$30 per half-hour lesson with a limit of two lessons. Day and overnight participants may enroll during the camp registration process.

PARTICIPANTS

MMC welcomes middle and high school-aged vocalists, instrumentalists, and pianists from across the United States. Participants should be between the ages of 11-18, currently be in middle or high school or have just graduated, be able to read music independently, and have completed at least one year of music study in a school or community band, choir, piano class, or have taken private lessons.

INSTRUCTION

A variety of large ensemble rehearsals and masterclasses in performance technique, music theory, conducting, improvisation, and music literature are led by University of Montevallo music faculty and guest artists. Private vocal or instrumental lessons with University faculty are available for an additional fee.

FACULTY AND STAFF

Our faculty are nationally and internationally recognized performers, conductors, composers, music theorists, musicologists, and music educators. All hold doctoral degrees in their area of expertise and have enjoyed extensive teaching careers working with students of all ages and abilities. Additionally, music majors at the University of Montevallo, most of whom were MMC participants, serve as camp counselors.
