2) To be issued an Alabama CPA certificate, candidates may choose from the following pathways: 1) Must have completed a total of 120 semester hours of postsecondary education including a total of 24 semester hours in accounting (excluding introductory courses) along with 2 years of experience working in accounting or 2) Must have completed 150 hours (can be either 150 hours at the undergraduate level or a bachelors plus a masters degree) including 33 semester hours in accounting (excluding introductory courses) along with 1 year of experience working in accounting.
