Transfer students seeking to select courses that most closely match the degree programs at the University of Montevallo should choose the following Alabama community college course options from the Alabama Transfers guide. A maximum of **sixty hours** of credit will transfer from a two-year college.

Area V - Pre-Professional, Major, & Elective Courses. Select up to 19 semester hours.

Select HEC 140 – Principles of Nutrition or CUA 111 – Foundations of Nutrition

If not taken in Area II choose:

SPH 106 – Fundamentals of Oral Communication or SPH 107 – Fundamentals of Public Speaking
One additional 3 semester hour course in Area II

Select one additional 3 semester hour courses in Area II

For a B.S. degree – fill the remaining hours toward completion of an additional 7 hours of Math and/or Science electives.

For a B.A. degree – fill the remaining hours towards completion of the second-year sequence of a world language OR complete the first-year sequence of two different world languages.

Any remaining hours may be taken from courses in Area II-IV that have not already been taken.
