Area V - Pre-Professional, Major, & Elective Courses. Select up to 23 semester hours.

(If not taken in [Area II](#)) choose:

SPH 106 – Fundamentals of Oral Communication *or* SPH 107 – Fundamentals of Public Speaking

Advanced standing in music from other accredited institutions is determined by audition in the primary performance area and appropriate examinations in music theory, ear training, sight singing, music history, and functional piano.

MUS 111 – Music Theory I and MUS 113 – Music Theory Lab I
MUS 112 – Music Theory II and MUS 114 – Music Theory Lab II
MUL 101 – Class Piano I
MUL 102 – Class Piano II

Performance Courses – up to 4 semesters (individual performance instruction – taken from MUP courses – must include a complete sequence in a single instrument).

Music Ensemble – up to 4 semesters (MUL 180 or above).

For a B.M. degree – no additional courses.

For a B.A. degree – fill the remaining hours towards completion of the second-year sequence of a world language OR complete the first-year sequence of two different world languages.
